3. Any information that would support the application, such as a current resume or experience in a foreign country.
4. A brief statement of what subject(s) he/she wants to teach.
5. Teaching Evaluations from the past 2 years.

NOTE: Assistantships will depend upon the availability of funds, which may not be ascertained until late June. Candidates may also be requested to interview with the instructor in charge of the relevant course.
